When we receive the bread and wine of this meal, we receive his body and blood "in, with, and under the forms" of the consecrated bread and wine. All of God's beautiful children are welcome to our Lord's table — it's our Lord's table, after all, and all are invited. Let's be clear — it is not "my" table, or "our" table or a "Lutheran" table. It is our Lord's table, and he sends out the invitations — to everyone under the sun. This includes you to come forward just as are.

For the bread we provide two types of host, with gluten and without. If you would like gluten free let Pastor Paul know when you come forward. We offer both red wine and white grape juice.

#### To the Parents of Children:

Relax! God put the wiggle in children; don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house. All are welcome! Sit toward the front where it is easier for children to see and hear what is going on. Little one's tire of seeing the back of others' heads.



If you have to leave the service with your child, feel free to, but please come back. As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me."



## FIRST READING: Galatians 5:1, 13-25

Christ set us free so that we would live free. So, don't ever give in to slavery again. You were made for freedom, brothers and sisters. The entire law is in this one sentence, "Love your neighbor as yourself." Don't take bites out of each other so that there is nothing left of you.



THE HOLY GOSPEL: Luke 9:51-62 People: Glory to you, O Lord.

Jesus got more focused the closer he got to Jerusalem. He sent some messengers ahead of himself into a Samaritan village to get things ready. But the villagers wanted to have nothing to do with him because he was so intent on going to Jerusalem. James and John saw this, and said, "So do you want us to destroy them for you, Jesus?" 

Now and forever. Amen.


#### RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION


